

Parent Chaperone Instructions

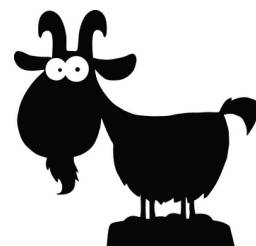
1. Remove this cover slip from the attached permission slip.
