## 1850s: Slavery & Compromise

- 1. Turn to **AN469**. Locate the *green* areas on the reference map.
  - 1a. Color Minnesota Territory, Washington Territory & Oregon Territory **pale blue**. ["pale blue" is even lighter than "light blue"]
  - 1b. Color the remaining green states **light blue** on your map.
- 2. Now locate the *orange* areas on the reference map.
  - 2a. Color Indian Territory **pale brown**. [again, "pale" is lighter than "light"]
  - 2b. Color the remaining orange states **light brown** on your map.
- 3. Locate the *dark orange* and *yellow* areas on the reference map.
  - 3a. Color these areas alternating pale blue and pale brown.
- 4. Label all the states and territories using **black**.
- 5. Draw the Missouri Compromise Line on your map using **red**. Label it with **black**.
- 6. Using **RM40c**, draw on the Underground Railroad routes using **medium brown**. Don't try to draw all of the routes on the reference map. Condense them down to four, or five.
